Trish's team also conducts environmental review and permitting of park development projects as well as manages the County Trails Program to ensure a viable, connective trails network throughout the unincorporated communities. Before DPR, Trish was the Environmental Resource Manager with the County of San Diego Department of Planning and Land Use. Her projects included planning of the North and East County MSCP Plans, the Otay River Watershed Management Plan and implementation of the adopted South County MSCP Subarea Plan.
